It may be hard to believe, but Summer is almost Here! Where did the year go? As we transition into our summer program, we will say "See you until the next school year" to some of our school friends and "Hello" or "Welcome Back" to friends joining us for the Summer.

Our Summer Program will begin Monday, June 26th. As we prepare for the Transition to Summer, Teachers will start talking about the upcoming changes and addressing the transitions that the children will be experiencing. The Hi-5s and the Stargazers will become one class. The Sunshine's, The Kindness Crew, and The Penguins will all remain the same.

Teachers will take vacations or days off throughout the Summer, so staff schedules may change to accommodate enrollment. We will inform you when teachers will be on vacation and who is subbing in their classroom.

As always, we will make these changes and transitions as smooth as possible.



Just a Few Brief Reminders

A two-week notice is required for any vacation request. You may email your vacation requests or write them down on the vacation request form, which is next to the tuition box.

Please send in a sun hat, sunscreen, and Bug Spray. Please keep in mind that for most sunscreen to be effective, it needs to be applied well before sun exposure, so it is best to apply sunscreen to your child at home before they come to school, and then we will reapply sunscreen as needed.

Spray sunblock is impractical for a school setting, and we prefer sunblock lotion instead. Send Insect Repellant for protection against those pesky bugs (ticks are out). We ask that you label any sunscreen or insect repellent you send in with your child's name. We ask that you send in a bug spray instead of lotion, as it is much easier to apply.

TICKS-Every tick case will be different; we will call you if we find a tick embedded in your child; it will be your decision whether or not we pull it out, or you can come and do it here. We will save the tick in scotch tape if there needs to be a follow-up with your child's doctor.

Sneakers are best! If your child wears shoes without socks, please send in an extra pair to protect their feet during rest time & we ask that you send in a seasonal change of clothes and a water bottle if you have not already done so. Ensure all your child's belongings are labeled with your child's name. Please include an ice pack, a beverage, and necessary utensils daily in your child's lunch box.
